Council for the Municipality of the District of Yarmouth has identified the following six priorities, in no particular order.

- 1) **Rural Internet: (Regional)** Council's strategy is to support business and economic development, drive population growth, meet citizen demand, provide an equitable level of service and leverage the infrastructure installed to improve cell phone service for resident safety and convenience.
- 2) **Business Park:** Council's course of action is to provide serviced lots to attract new businesses, support future economic growth and increase employment.
- 3) **Yarmouth International Airport: (Regional)** Council's plan is to support regional economic development by supplementing the current ferry and road transportation network with an air traffic option; attract new economic activity (business, tourists); and to protect the safety and lives of citizens by providing 24-7 access for medical and coast guard services.
- 4) **Mariners Centre: (Regional)** Council's strategy is to create a solid foundation to make decisions to meet the needs of residents for recreational programming and management of capital expansion; support a coordinated approach among three municipal units to maximize resources and; ensure appropriate governance structure and Board membership is in place.
- 5) **Cape Forchu:** Council is to maintain a capital asset in good condition to attract tourists and tourism revenue to the area.
- 6) **Active Transportation:** Council's plan is to support the vision of a healthy, vibrant, and sustainable community to provide residents and visitors with active transportation routes and activities, investing in design upgrades and development that will create a connected network of multi-use trails, bike lanes, and sidewalks.

Fees Eliminated for Criminal Record Checks and Vulnerable Sector Checks

Residents of the Municipality of Yarmouth are no longer required to pay a fee and obtain a receipt from the Municipal Office in Hebron for a criminal record check or a vulnerable sector check. However, residents may still require a letter from the organization requesting the criminal record check or vulnerable sector check to bring to the Yarmouth County RCMP Detachment.

If you live within the Municipality of Yarmouth you can apply in-person for a Criminal Record Check / Vulnerable Sector Check from the Yarmouth Rural RCMP Detachment on Starrs Road on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. (closed from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm for lunch).

Property Tax Rebate for Seniors

The Property Tax Rebate for Seniors Program, administered by Access Nova Scotia on behalf of the Department of Community Services, is designed to help eligible seniors by providing an annual rebate on municipal property taxes. The program provides eligible homeowners with a rebate (determined by the Provincial Government) on municipal property taxes paid the previous year.
