

ADDENDUM No. 3

RFP – Hebron – Dayton Sewer System Infiltration and Inflow (I/I) Study

Dated: December 1, 2021

Here are few more questions and answers for clarity:

Q 1. What is the duration of the monitoring period?

Ans. An experienced consultant would have a good understanding about the minimum monitoring duration required based on their previously conducted I & I studies. MODY would like to see proponent’s judgement reflected in the proposal under “Approach and methodology”.

Q 2. How many residential/commercial/industrial units are on the system?

Ans. There are 276 residential and 30 commercial units. There are no industrial units. The commercial units can be home based businesses, auto repair shops or rental units.

Q 3. How many homes should be assumed for the home inspection component?

Ans. The final number of home inspections will depend on visual inspection, monitoring and smoke testing of the system. However, for the sake of proposal use 40% of the total units mentioned above.

Q 4. For proposal submission, would you accept a digital copy via email and a courier stamp for submission of the hard copy before the day and time of proposal due date? This would ensure that our proposal would be reviewed if there are issues with courier delivery

Ans. As long as MODY receives your hard copy submissions before the closing time there will be no issue.
